Chronic foot pain

- heel pain syndrome

- metatarsalgia
- posterior tibial syndrome
- sesamoiditis
- abductor hallucis strain
- soft tissue injury secondary to bone deformity

Pressure Lesions

- ulcers
- keratomas (corns and callouses)

Dermatological pathologies

- nail pathologies
- mycotic infections
- plantar warts
- hyperhidrosis/bromidrosis
- hyperkeratosis
- psoriasis

Postural symptoms secondary to foot function affecting

- lower back
- hip
- knee

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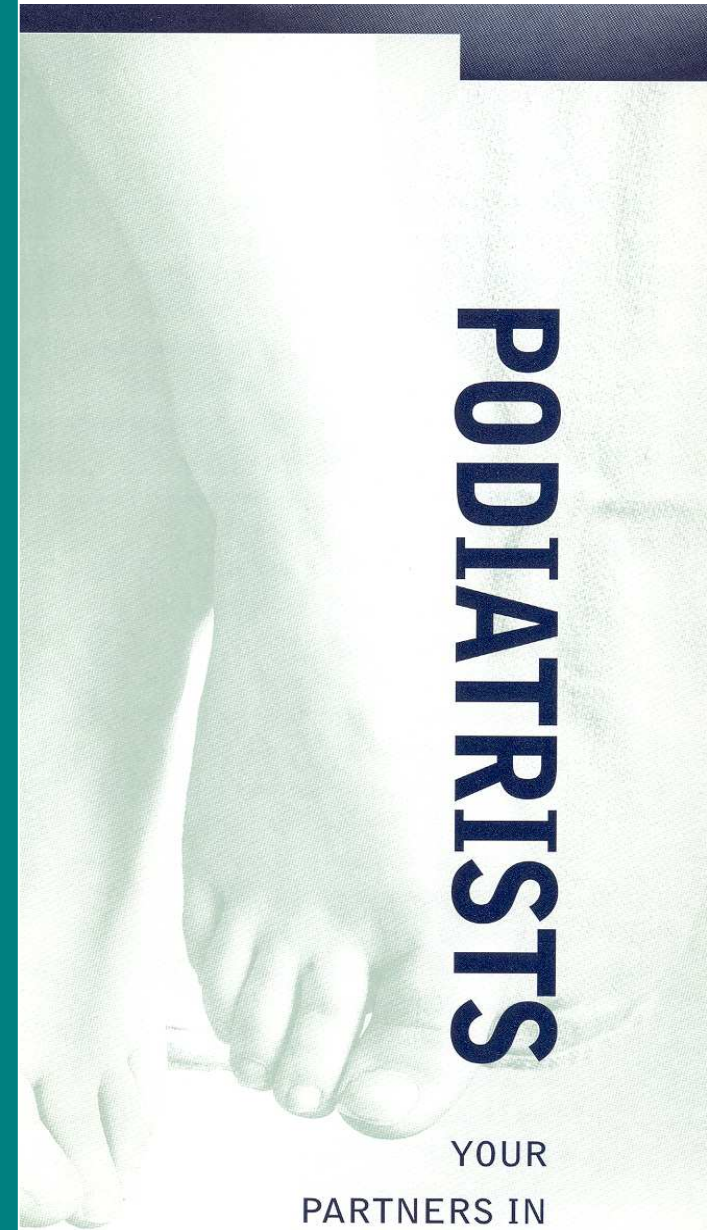
