Youth Program Rules of Conduct

Any client on probation, parole, or attending due to a court order, must not violate the conditions of their respective orders. Any violations will be reported to the appropriate authorities immediately. If a client has been ordered to attend a counseling or treatment program, then it is in the best interest of the client to complete their sessions or programs.

“In layman's terms, it is up to you the client.”

Any client that comes in for counseling sessions or to attend Youth Program must sign in with the youth counselor. This will be for record of attendance.

There will be **absolutely no tolerance for violence** of any kind. This includes any physical or emotional abuse; this is a safe place and people deserve to feel safe.

Weapons are not permitted in the Native Addictions Council of Manitoba (N.A.C.M.) building. Anyone found carrying a weapon into the building will be asked to leave immediately.

Any clients who are here to see the Youth Counselor or to attend workshops are not allowed in the Pritchard House residents living quarters, on the second or third floors.

If any client is unable to attend their counseling sessions with the youth Counselor please have **respect and take responsibility**, phone and let the Counselor or Secretary know ahead of time that you will not be able to attend. This is so the counselor may schedule another client in for a session. Clients under a Probation order must submit a note stating why they were unable to attend their session(s) note from the doctor or lawyer etc. To verify their whereabouts as absences will go on file

Confidentiality and respect are stressed when clients are in to attend workshops or group meetings, where others will be sharing personal aspects of their lives. “What you hear here, who you see here, when you leave here, let it stay here.”

“Treat others, the way you want to be treated.”

N.A.C.M. is not responsible for lost or stolen property. No phone calls are allowed during client sessions or Youth Programs, exceptions will be made in emergency situations.

I have read or had explained to me, the Youth Program Rules, and understand that I must abide by them during the time that I am attending my counseling sessions or any other programs. I understand that failure to abide by these rules may result in dismissal from the program.
