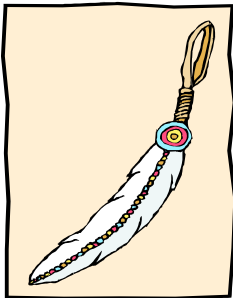

The belief of N.A.C.M. is that each person has the right to wellness, success and self-determination.

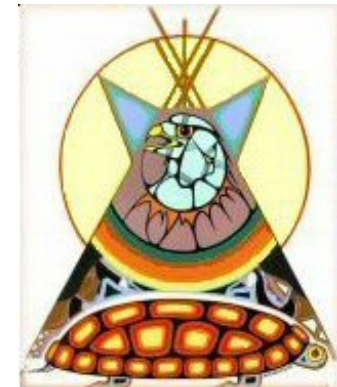

# N.A.C.M.

Native Addictions Council of Manitoba Youth Program is a non-profit organization that provides a holistic concept of healing: mind, body, and spirit to a b o r i g i n a l and non-aboriginal youth pursuing a healthy and substance free lifestyle.



Many of the services we offer here are the prevention and intervention of alcohol use, drug use and the use of many other substances. N.A.C.M. also educates the youth life skills that are required, using various traditional values such as the seven teachings, medicine wheel and storytelling.

The youth counselor provides a safe environment for one to one counseling, encouragement, support and motivation for personal growth, achievements and accomplishments, respecting the confidentiality of our youth.

N.A.C.M. is offering services to youth ages 10 to 20. The youth counselor offers assessments, individual counseling, and referrals to other agencies.

## Youth Group

The Youth Group is offered bi-weekly to N.A.C.M. youth participants, for more information contact the youth counselor.

## Registration

Registration forms can be filled out at the office with the guidance of the youth counselor. Once the forms are all completed an assessment will be conducted to determine further action.
